Since 1899, United for Literacy, formerly Frontier College, has offered free learner-centred tutoring and mentoring programs to empower individuals and communities from coast to coast to coast with the fundamental reading, writing, and numeracy skills they need to navigate everyday life.

Unfortunately, today, more than one million children in Canada—at least one in eight—are not reading at grade level. And according to the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), almost 1 in 5 adults have literacy skills too low to independently complete daily tasks.

Our programs address specific needs, especially for those who experience barriers or who struggle in mainstream education systems. With your support, in 2024 we intend to reach more children and youth in underserved, remote, or isolated communities.
